YOM KIPPUR

There is **NO SCHOOL** on Sunday, Erev Yom Kippur. If you would like to daven at the Yeshiva, Shacharis will be at 8:00 A.M. beginning with Selichos.

Kol Nidre will be at 6:25 p.m. Your sons should try to arrive at the Yeshiva at least 30 minutes before Kol Nidre, so that they can get settled in their room. There will be a list with room assignments for all the Chicago area students. They should bring all bedding (pillow, sheets and blanket) as the Yeshiva only supplies this for the students in the dormitory.

Maariv after Yom Kippur will conclude around 7:55 p.m. Allowing time for the boys to get their bedding and other personal items, I would suggest pickup at around 8:10 p.m. Of course, if any of the boys want to eat dinner first and then get picked up that would be fine.



Shemini Atzeres-Simchas Torah

Many Rabbeim and Talmidim will be participating together in the Yeshiva for the whole YomTov and more will be walking to the Yeshiva for Hakafos. We thank all the boys who signed up to stay and eat in the Yeshiva for Shemini Atzeres –

However, I want to emphasize that the Yeshiva will NOT be able to supervise anyone walking to and from the Yeshiva. However, Rabbi Schuman will be walking from Congregation Adas Yeshurun to the Yeshiva at 9:15 p.m. He will be dancing Hakafof at the Yeshiva and then he will leave at 12:00 a.m. and return to Adas Yeshurun at 12:45 a.m. All students from West Rogers Park walking to the Yeshiva for Hakafof are encouraged to walk with Rabbi Schuman and return with him to Adas Yeshurun.
