

JC Programs for Yeshivas Hakayitz 2010

The JC program is a great opportunity for mature campers who wish to undertake aspects of camp responsibility and leadership. JC positions are available to campers who have completed 11th or 12th grade

All campers who come to camp as a JC;

Participate in the morning learning program with Teen Kollel

Participate in one of the afternoon sports programs

Attend all evening trips together with Yeshivas Hakayitz or Teen Kollel

A first year JC receives \$250 dollars payment for his successful work as a JC and a second year JC receives \$350

Junior counselors reside in a bunk of younger campers together with the counselor of that bunk. A Junior counselor must be committed to assisting his counselor in all areas. This includes participation in the daily sports and bunk activities for his bunk. **A JC also must abide by his bunk's curfew time on a rotation basis, alternating with the bunk counselor.**

Junior counselors will be asked to assist in one or more of the camps enrichment electives or camp jobs. These jobs may include; equipment room assistant, infirmary and office assistant, canteen assistant, video assistant, and more.
